CAMERA SYSTEM – SEWER DEPARTMENT

Service Director Tomaselli explained that the current camera in the Sewer Department is ten years old and the software is inadequate. He is proposing to purchase a Cues Camera System which is the same as the current camera. The cost through State bid is \$78,250. The company will do the installation and give two days of training. There is \$80,000 in the budget for this purchase. Council agreed to the purchase of the Cues Camera System.

GEOMELT – SALT ADDITIVE

Mr. Tomaselli is proposing to buy a product which contains beet juice which would coat the salt as it hits the ground. As the salt is coated, it would coat the street. The streets would first be plowed and salt would be put down. The second time the street would only be plowed. The third time salt would be put down again. Mr. Tomaselli said it would be a cost savings to the city by not salting the second time. The city would buy three units to use this product at \$2,100 each and a \$300 freight cost. The company will deliver 4400 gallons of the product each time at a cost of \$3.00/gal. The start up cost would be \$22,000. The Committee agreed to the purchase of this product.

SHREDDER PLANT STUDY

Mr. Tomaselli said it is estimated that there is about 7,000/8,000 tons left to fill at the landfill. He suggested selling and removing the shredder building to make more room to fill. CT Consultants has done a preliminary study of the property and has suggested recreational uses once the landfill is filled. Council gave approval for the Service Director to obtain informal quotes to sell the shredder building.
