**MAYOR'S REPORT** – Mayor Anderson referred to Mrs. Langal's concern regarding the condition of the properties in her neighborhood. He stated that a lot of times we are dealing with foreclosures and out-of-state banks which becomes time consuming. He said the city is working on an ordinance that will allow us to be more aggressive in these instances.

**OTHER REPORTS**

**Law Director Wiles** – Commented on the residency requirement being taken out of the Firefighter's contract. The Supreme Court says that cities can't have residency requirements. Mr. Wiles said that the Supreme Court is cutting into the cities' ability to exercise home rule under their charter.

**Service Director Tomaselli** – Reported that the water line on Robinhood and Kilarney is done. Complaints from residents regarding problems from this project are being given to the county to address. The Vine Street lining will start at the end of the month. Frabrizi will be starting the project on Erie Rd. CT is reviewing the video for the lining project on Grove Ave. The contractor was started boring on Kirtland Rd. Mr. Tomaselli said he has asked ODOT to change the lights at Vine Street when they change the lights at Rt. 91 and

Rt. 2 in order to help traffic flow. The ramps that are closed on the Rt. 2 project will be closed for 45 days. Discussion followed regarding the traffic problems caused by all the projects.

Councilman Woodin asked the status of Figgie Outfall Project. Mr. Wiles answered that an ordinance will be on the next meeting to re-bid the project.

Councilman Woodin said he noticed landscaping being done on Hodgson Rd. to the east where the new sidewalk is supposed to go. Mr. Tomaselli will contact the new project manager of Ryan Homes about the sidewalks.

**City Engineer Sayles** – Commented that Lake County Dept. of Utilities was very cooperative in adding extra pavement on the Robinhood and Kilarney project. They did not use all the money from an OPWC Grant and are giving what is left to our city to help pay for that cost.

**Parks & Recreation Director Katz**– No report. Councilman Ranally asked how the condition of the golf course is. Mr. Katz said that the seeding is 80% complete. The driving range has been very busy. Councilman Black asked how much of the good numbers shown for the golf course (April Statistics Report) are attributed to the driving range. Mr. Katz said the rounds are doing very well. Income wise, Mr. Katz said “you can’t beat a driving range”. Councilman Woodn asked if early bird registration for recreation was over. Mr. Katz said it is over for camp, but still on for swimming until next Sat.
