Ray DelaMotte, Architect, represented this site and elevations plans for Phase II for an addition to connect two buildings. Variances were granted at the February 11, 2009 Board of Zoning Appeals for front yard parking for handicap parking, 59 parking spaces of the required 166 spaces (11 of the spaces are at 4439 Hamann Pkwy) and a 38 foot front yard setback of the required 60 feet.

Chairman Irvine was concerned about the variance for 59 parking spaces when 48 spaces were on the 4428 Hamann Pkwy lot and 11 spaces were on the 4399 Hamann Pkwy site. Chairman Irvine stated that based on the motion for granting 59 parking spaces at the BZA meeting, 59 parking spaces should be on the 4428 site and not 48 spaces. Richard Smith, Chief Bldg. & Zoning Inspector, stated that Paulo Products owns both properties therefore can use the 4399 site for additional parking for the 4428 site. The 4399 site had more spaces than was needed for their use.
