Sign Permit Procedures

Upon submission of application (and ALL requirements listed below) there is due and payable an application fee of \$25.75. A zoning review will be performed to determine compliance with Willoughby Codified Ordinance 1163 Sign. **Please provide 6 color copies of the renderings.**

The application will then be forwarded to the Secretary who will confirm, via correspondence, the next available meeting at which your proposal will be heard by either the Sign or Design Review Board (if located within the Historical District). For current Board meeting and deadline schedules, contact Mrs. Grinstead.

Meetings are held at Willoughby City Hall, One Public Square, Willoughby on specified evenings. A representative is required to appear before the Board to represent the proposal.

Upon approval by the Board, notice will be forwarded to the Building Department with authorization to issue a Sign Permit to a **registered sign or general contractor only**. Permit fees are listed below.

\$50.00 + \$0.50/Sq.ft. + 3% (Tax)

\$30.00 + \$0.50/Sq.ft. + 3% (Tax)

\$40.00 + \$.050/Sq.sf. + 3% (Tax)

\$35.00

If illuminated, an electrical permit is required. If the electrical sign service is existing, the Sign Contractor may obtain the permit. If the electrical service needs to be run, then an Electrical Contractor shall obtain the electrical permit.
