2016 ROAD PAVING PROGRAM = SOM CENTER

We are bidding the City Road Program much earlier in the season hoping we can get ahead of everyone and complete before fighting late fall snow and weather. Usually we target about \$1M annually in paving and repairs. This year we have an extra large project that will impact all of us, with SOM being totally resurfaced all the way from the Lake County line (south end of Willoughby Hills) to Route 2. This is a State of OH project but the City share will still be \$450,000, which will be added to our normal \$1M in City wide projects. Look for more details as we get closer but this will have a big impact on our local travel this summer.

BEIDLER ROAD WATERLINE PROJECT

Starting the week of March 14th, Lake County Water will be putting in a new waterline on Beidler Road. The southbound lane will be closed from Euclid Avenue to the railroad tracks. This project will take at least 2 months so please plan alternate routes if Beidler Road is in your travel plans.
