## CITY HALL RENOVATION

City Hall remodeling project is progressing nicely. The top floor is almost complete and City Administration - Mayor, Finance, Law; are all moved into their new offices. The main floor, which will house Building and Service Departments, is now under construction. The last phase will include the lower level Council Chambers and public meeting rooms.

## RT. 91 SIGNAL PROJECT

RT 91 and Euclid Avenue Signal Improvement project is progressing. The bid opening is in May and we should see construction starting later this summer. This will be an extensive modification to the lane structure so expect quite a bit of dirt moving and construction mess to take place with this project. New signals and better alignment of traffic lanes, especially heading south on RT 91 towards this intersection.

## GRASS STICKERS on sale now!

The City of Willoughby continues to offer grass-clipping collections as part of our waste collection service. The service is designed for those who do not mulch or compost their grass. A grass-clipping sticker can be purchased from the Service Department, located at City Hall. The cost of the sticker is \$20.00. This year's sticker is yellow and is designed to be placed on **your 32-gallon container**. Grass clipping collection begins April 1st and continues thru November 30<sup>th</sup> 2010. Grass clippings **will not be picked up** without a current sticker and proper container.
