CONSTRUCTION PROJECT SR 91 & US 20

Busiest intersection in the county and traffic will be disrupted for two months.

- On Monday April 25th, the north bound left lane of Sr-91 between Kaiser Court and Sr-2 will close for a duration of 30 days. This will limit traffic to one lane in this section; however, the turn lanes onto both east and west bound US-20 will be maintained.
- Around June 1 sporadic lane closure will be utilized both US-20 and Sr-91 while the asphalt wearing course is placed. All traffic will be maintained; however, some traffic congestion is probable.
- Sporadic lane closures will continue in the intersection of US-20 & Sr-91 and US-20 & Plaza Drive while the new signals are activated.
- Project completion is scheduled for June 30th.

EDISON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION

Work is underway to add classrooms to Edison Elementary School in time for next year opening day. Original plans requested an access drive directly onto RT 91 for bus traffic. This request was denied based on density of traffic and increased safety concerns. Part of the project will include a retention basin at the northwest corner of the property (closest to Big Turtle 1), which is intended to better control storm water runoff and minimize any impact to neighboring properties. You will see some trees being removed in order to tie into the sanitary lines running down the turning lane of SOM. So yes, for at least a few days this summer you will have further traffic delays while they do the connection.
