RT. 2 WIDENING PROJECT

RT 2 Widening Project continues and of course traffic remains a mess, especially around Lost Nation Road. In our area, the RT 91 eastbound entrance has also been closed which combined with the lane activity in Eastlake is causing a real nightmare trying to get on RT 2 from Willoughby. The RT 91 eastbound entrance ramp is supposed to reopen around June 17th so a little patience and we will be done with that disruption.

RT. 91 SIGNAL PROJECT

The RT 91 and Euclid Avenue signalization project has been awarded to Karvo Paving by ODOT for \$1.3M This extensive project will include paving of RT 91 north to RT 2. Project will begin later this summer and continue until next year.

GRASS STICKERS on sale now!

The City of Willoughby continues to offer grass-clipping collections as part of our waste collection service. The service is designed for those who do not mulch or compost their grass. A grass-clipping sticker can be purchased from the Service Department, located at City Hall. The cost of the sticker is \$20.00. This year's sticker is yellow and is designed to be placed on **your 32-gallon container**. Grass clipping collection begins April 1st and continues thru November 30th 2010. Grass clippings **will not be picked up** without a current sticker and proper container.
