WATER PIPE LINING PROJECT

Some of you may have noticed Lake Water getting ready to start a lining project for a water main that supplies water to the Tower at 84 and 91. The line runs from Euclid Avenue, south on Franklyn Commons property, along the eastern edge of Oakridge, across the western edge of Willow Creek and then along the west and south sides of Big Turtle II. Should only be a few excavations but please note you may see some activity in easements along your property.
