FORMER FX FITNESS Update (Pine Ridge Plaza on SOM)

Exciting news to share as there is a project moving forward that will tear down the old fitness center and replace with a new strip center to match architecture of the existing plaza.



The new building will have 4 units: STARBUCKS with drive thru, Moe's Southwest (Mexican restaurant), a pet store and unit to be determined.

Review of the plans has been extensive. Drive thru will be closest to Bruegger's Bagel with speakers facing in that direction. No cleaning of exhaust grills during late hours - all in consideration of nearby residential properties. There have been some concerns expressed about additional traffic and renewed requests to consider a right turn only lane at Halle and SOM. I asked our City Engineer for his opinion and a traffic analysis was completed. What was determined is that adding a right turn only lane would have serious, negative impact for the entire SOM corridor. If you are interested, I can share details of this analysis.
