### LOST NATION GOLF COURSE



As of May 1, 2020, we are open for play daily, with the restrictions listed below. Our hours moving forward at this time are 12-Close during the week and 8-4 on the weekends when weather and course conditions permit. **We WILL be sending out single rider carts starting on May 2 and moving forward.** Our hours

during the week will be 9 holes only with a cart from 12 to 3. You can walk 9 or 18 holes from Noon to one, and then it will be 9 holes walking from 1-3. This has to be done to ensure all the carts are back in time for our league play. From 3 to close, we will be open for our league play only as we have to watch our capacity. From the end of leagues until 7 pm, we will have walking only availability as we need to get carts in to clean and sanitize. Weekends will be carts throughout the day with our last 18 hole cart out at 2 pm and our last 9 hole cart at 4. Walking only from 4 to 6.

**OUR DRIVING RANGE WILL BE OPEN STARTING MAY 2. BALLS WILL BE PURCHASED INSIDE THE CLUBHOUSE, AND WE WILL HAND THE CUSTOMERS THE BASKET WITH THEM FILLED. WE WILL HAVE A BASKET RETURN AREA. WE WILL ONLY ACCEPT PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD PER ORDERS FROM THE LAKE COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT.**

We still are not allowed to serve food or drinks and are awaiting word on whether we can open the golf shop up for payment and purchasing of merchandise, we will update again when a decision is made. There will be no flag sticks, and we will raise the cups, so you have to hit the cup for the putt to count, and no scorecards put out as well. When you finish playing, you do need to leave the premises immediately, so no congregation occurs. We will not be accepting walk-ups but could give you a tee time if one is available when you arrive, we also will accept tee times for single players only as well during these difficult times. Please call us at 440-953-4280, and we will reserve a tee time for you, if there is no answer, please leave your name and phone number, and we will call you back to schedule a tee time. We hope to keep us all safe and still allow our customers a chance to get some golf in. **Take care, stay safe and we look forward to seeing you all again soon.**

CITY OF WILLOUGHBY  
TRASH • RECYCLING • YARD WASTE



Effective Monday, April 27th, Republic Services will resume bulk and yard waste collections. Please see notes below from Republic:

- \* All items that are not carted will be required to be bagged and sealed
- \* Recycling must be contained in the cart
- \* We still may need to use alternative disposal methods if there are disruptions to recycling processing capabilities or if recycling contamination continues to increase. It is important to keep waste out of your recycling container and do not bag your recyclables
- \* Yard waste must be bagged biodegradable bags or personal can marked "yard waste"; must be under 50 pounds
- \* Sticks bundled no longer than 4ft and 4 inches in diameter and no heavier than 30 pounds
- \* Bulk furniture needs to be wrapped; mattresses need to be placed in mattress bags
- \* Carpeting needs to be in strips at 8in diameter rolled up and no longer than 4ft
- \* We may see a surge of material initially that takes us a little longer to collect and clear than normal



**2020 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

**ERIE STREET WATERLINE REPLACEMENT**

The Lake County Water Department will be replacing water main and hydrants on Erie Road from East Spaulding to Vine Street. Upon completion of the water line work, the street will be repaved. **The Downtown Willoughby Water Main replacement project is now roughly three weeks ahead of schedule.** Replacing water lines that were roughly 100 years old was the major objective of the project funded primarily by the county. When complete, new water lines, curbs, pavers, and paving. A FRESH NEW LOOK for DTW.

**ERIE STREET RECONSTRUCTION**

The City of Willoughby will be reconstructing Erie Street from the Norfolk and Southern rail crossing to the CSX rail crossing. This work will include storm sewer drainage work, paving replacement, new curbs, sidewalks, and aprons. Construction is tentatively scheduled from Mid-May through August.

**LAKESHORE BOULEVARD RESURFACING**

The resurfacing of Lake Shore Blvd. from the Western Corporation Line to the Eastern Corporation Line will begin in early fall and be completed by the end of the construction season in November.

**364, E.365 AND HARVARD ROAD STORM SEWER PROJECT**

This project is currently underway and includes hydrant relocation as well as storm sewer construction work. Completion is scheduled for some time in the early summer.

**WARD CREEK STORMWATER PROJECT**

This project calls for improvements along Ward Creek and is scheduled for early summer commencement with completion in January of 2021.

**STORM OUTFALL REPAIR PROJECT**

This work will take place in various areas of the City this summer, with actual locations to be updated prior to commencement.
