

WILLOUGHBY FIRE DEPARTMENT – PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER

Qualifications:

Candidates must hold a current State of Ohio emergency medical technician certification and be a state of Ohio Level II firefighter. Applicants must be citizens of the United States, be a high school graduate or possess a valid GED certification and carry a valid Ohio motor vehicle operator's license with good driving record. Applicants must be able to maintain all required minimum qualifications and certifications throughout employment. Applicants must meet annual training requirements and required hours.

Minimum Requirements:

Applications must be filled out entirely with the following information requirements attached (see check sheet)

- Current State of Ohio Firefighter Level 1 Certification (120 Hour class)
- Documentation of Hazardous Materials Operations.
- Current State of Ohio Emergency Medical Technician Basic or Paramedic

Applicants must have a current (completed in the last year) Cuyahoga Community College firefighter agility test certificate. If given a conditional offer, eligible candidates must perform the following: a pre-employment medical examination, drug screening, and an in-depth background investigation.

Nature of Work: The protection of life and property through fire suppression, fire prevention, public education, emergency medical service, hazardous materials and technical rescue.
