

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-78


AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A PERMANENT EASEMENT FROM BRUCE C. AND BOBBI R. SUNDMAN FOR SIDEWALK PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That a permanent easement to install, repair, maintain, rebuild, or replace a sidewalk from Bruce C. and Bobbi R. Sundman for a portion of Permanent Parcel No. 27A-020-D-00-013-0 is hereby accepted by the City of Willoughby; said easement substantially in the form now on file with the Law Department.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to install the sidewalk at the same time as the road paving project; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
