THE SAFETY SERVICES LEVY

Issue 2 will support our First Responders by funding a carefully crafted, comprehensive, cost-effective safety services plan that includes:

- Converting the former Meister Media building (37733 Euclid Ave.) into a modern law enforcement facility with space for new technology, training, enhanced dispatch, jail, and features that will strengthen the performance of our police department.
- Purchasing a new ladder truck that will enhance WFD's ability to protect our homes and businesses.
- Creating a sustainable revenue stream that will enable the city to meet the equipment and technology needs of our First Responders today and tomorrow.

Issue 2 Information and Figures:

- Issue 2 is a 2.5 mills continuous property tax levy that will appear on the ballot this spring.
- Issue 2 will cost \$88 per \$100,000 of appraised home value annually.
- Issue 2 cannot be used for wages or benefits.
- Issue 2 will keep our families, neighborhoods, businesses, and city safe.
