

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITIES OF WILLOUGHBY, WICKLIFFE, AND WILLOWICK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Willoughby, Wickliffe and Willowick have identified the need to resurface Euclid Avenue (US 20) from the Lake County western line in Wickliffe to SOM Center Road (SR-91) in Willoughby in which Euclid Avenue area is located within the boundaries of the Cities of Willoughby, Wickliffe, and Willowick in Lake County; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) has approved the proposed improvement and has designated the project as LAK US 20-0.00; PID 122310; and

WHEREAS, Willoughby, Wickliffe and Willowick have agreed to cooperate to complete the resurfacing project; and

WHEREAS, Wickliffe shall act as the lead local agency for the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Cities of Willoughby, Wickliffe and Willowick to establish the obligations of each City for resurfacing Euclid Avenue, which project is identified as LAK US 20-0.00; PID 122310; said Memorandum of Understanding substantially in the form now on file in the Law Department.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to provide safe transportation for the citizens of Willoughby; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
