

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-74

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A TOTAL EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$126,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2025 FORD F-600 ONE TON TRUCK CHASSIS FROM CLASSIC AUTO GROUP FOR USE BY THE STREET DEPARTMENT AND THE ATTENDANT DUMP BODY INSTALLATION PACKAGE ON THE TRUCK BY BEST TRUCK EQUIPMENT, INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service received three (3) quotes for the purchase of one (1) one-ton dump truck for use by the Street Department; and

WHEREAS, the quote received from Classic Auto Group in the amount of \$56,000 for the purchase of one (1) 2025 Ford F-600 One Ton Truck Chassis was, in the opinion of the Council of the City, the lowest and best bid received thereon; and

WHEREAS, the quote received from Best Truck Equipment, Inc. in the amount of \$70,000 for the dump body installation package was, in the opinion of Council, the lowest and best bid received thereon; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to purchase one (1) 2025 Ford F-600 One Ton Truck Chassis from Classic Auto Group and the attendant dump body installation package on the truck by Best Truck Equipment, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an expenditure in the amount of \$56,000 for the purchase of one (1) 2025 Ford F-600 One Ton Truck Chassis for use by the Street Department is hereby approved and the Director of Public Service is authorized to proceed with such purchase from Classic Auto Group, 8540 Tyler Blvd., Mentor, OH 44060; said amount to be expended from the Capital Fund.


SECTION 2. That an expenditure in the amount of \$70,000 for the dump body installation package on the 2025 Ford F-600 One Ton Truck Chassis for use by the Street Department is hereby approved and the Director of Public Service is authorized to proceed with such purchase from Best Truck Equipment, Inc., 300 Temple Ave., Painesville, OH 44077; said amount to be expended from the Capital Fund.


SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason of limited availability; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
