

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-77**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING A 2014 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR SUV OWNED BY THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY AS OBSOLETE AND NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, AUTHORIZING THE SALE THEREOF TO ANDREWS OSBORNE ACADEMY, WILLOUGHBY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has determined that a 2014 Ford Police Interceptor SUV, VIN #1FM5K8AR7EGA65059, is obsolete and not needed for public use by the Willoughby Police Department and is hereby declared surplus; and

**WHEREAS**, Andrews Osborne Academy, Willoughby, Ohio desires to purchase the vehicle as a school security vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, the legislative authority may sell the vehicle according to R.C. 721.15(A); and

**WHEREAS**, Andrews Osborne Academy has offered to pay the sum of \$999 for the 2014 Ford Police Interceptor SUV;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to sell a 2014 Ford Police Interceptor SUV, VIN #1FM5K8AR7EGA65059, which is obsolete and not needed for public use by the Willoughby Police Department and is hereby declared surplus to Andrews Osborne Academy, Willoughby, Ohio for \$999, following the requirements of R.C. 721.15(A).

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to allow Andrews Osborne Academy immediate use of the vehicle; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


