

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-96

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A CERTAIN VEHICLE NO LONGER NECESSARY TO THE OPERATION OF THE WILLOUGHBY FIRE DEPARTMENT AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO TRANSFER THE VEHICLE TO THE HEIGHTS/HILLCREST TECHNICAL RESCUE TEAM WITHOUT COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, the Heights/Hillcrest Technical Rescue Team is comprised of multiple municipal fire departments in the area and pursuant to Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution and Ohio Revised Code Sections 9.60 and 715.02, which authorizes municipal corporations to enter into agreements with one another for the provisions of fire protection services on an emergency or regular basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby Fire Department is a present member and active participant in the programs of the Heights-Hillcrest Technical Rescue Team and in order to continue to and more efficiently organize, train, and equip a technical rescue team to conduct rescue activities requiring unusual training and/or equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That one (1) 2008 Chevrolet Express Van, VIN 1GNKG25K481145653 owned by the City and no longer needed for public purposes by the Willoughby Fire Department is hereby declared surplus.

SECTION 2. That the Safety Director is authorized to transfer the 2008 Chevrolet Express Van to the Heights/Hillcrest Technical Rescue Team, which transfer will continue in part to promote training and technical rescue equipment for the direct benefit of the City of Willoughby Fire Department.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and its approval by the Mayor, or at the earliest period allowed by law.
