

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-133**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CHIVERS CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,868,686.00 FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LAKESHORE BOULEVARD EAST EQUALIZATION BASIN PROJECT PHASE 2, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2025, bids were received by Verdantas LLC for the Lakeshore Boulevard East Equalization Basin Project Phase 2; and

**WHEREAS**, the bid received from Chivers Construction Co., Inc. was, in the opinion of the Council of the City, the lowest and best bid received thereon;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chivers Construction Co., Inc., 6700 Tow Road, Fairview, PA 16415 in the amount of \$9,868,686.00 for implementation of the Lakeshore Boulevard East Equalization Basin Project Phase 2, in accordance with the specifications and bid submitted; said amount to be expended from the Lakeshore East Equalization Basin Fund.

**SECTION 2.** That the Mayor is further authorized to execute any and all additional documents and forms necessary to the implementation of said contract.

**SECTION 3.** The bid deposit for the lowest and best bidder shall be returned upon execution of the contract.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

**SECTION 5.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to meet OEPA schedules; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
