This guide serves the purpose for those who prefer a basic understanding of our facility prior to attending.

AQUATIC FEATURES

Two Large Waterslides



Interactive In-water Play Structure



Six (6) 25-Meter Lap Lanes




Five (5) Multicolored Tipbuckets



- **Two (2) large waterslides** - both large waterslides are connected to the same tower.
- **In-water play structure** - includes interactive wheels to control water pressure & small slide for children.
 - The surrounding area has similar stand-alone interactive features.
- **Six (6) 25-Meter Lap Lanes** - all lanes start at four (4) feet with their deepest at five (5) feet.
- **Five (5) Multicolored Tipbuckets** - these fill with water, then spill over at random times.
- **Two (2) Zero-Depth Entry Points** - starting at deck level, and sloping into the water.

NOTE:

- **Swim test MUST** be taken if the patron is under 48" and wishes to either use the large waterslides or enter water deeper than 3'6".
 - The test consists of swimming 25 meters without touching the wall, floor, or lane line.
- **Noises to expect:**
 - Loud speaker for rest breaks & other events.
 - Lifeguards using their whistles & megaphones.
 - Water features with running water.
 - People talking and yelling.
- **Lifejackets & 2 water wheelchairs** are available for use free of charge at the First Aid door.
- **Rest Breaks (10 mins each)**
 - 1:30 PM, 3:30 PM, 5:30 PM
