

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-12

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A 2015 FORD EXPLORER INTERCEPTOR K9 VEHICLE OWNED BY THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY AS OBSOLETE AND NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE THEREOF TO THE VILLAGE OF TIMBERLAKE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined that a 2015 Ford Explorer Interceptor K9 vehicle, VIN #1FM5K8AR4FGA57132, is obsolete and not needed for public use by the Police Department and is hereby declared surplus; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Timberlake, Ohio desires to purchase the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of any subdivision may authorize, by ordinance, to enter into a contract for the purchase of equipment from any political subdivision of the state pursuant to Section 735.053; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Timberlake, Ohio has offered to pay the sum of \$100 for the vehicle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to sell a 2015 Ford Explorer Interceptor K9 vehicle, VIN #1FM5K8AR4FGA57132, which is obsolete and not needed for public use by the Willoughby Police Department and declared surplus, to the Village of Timberlake, Ohio for \$100, following the requirements of R.C. 735.053.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to allow for immediate possession of the vehicle by Timberlake; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
