**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2025-148
AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS
TOTALING \$42,315,156 FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND
OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF
WILLOUGHBY, OHIO, DURING THE PERIOD ENDING
MARCH 31, 2026, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That to provide for current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Willoughby, Ohio, during the period ending March 31, 2026, the following sums totaling \$42,315,156 are hereby set aside and appropriated from the funds hereinafter named:

SECTION 3. That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw her warrant for payment from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving certificates and vouchers therefore approved by the Board of Officers authorized by law to approve same; or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except employed by authority of, or in accordance with, law or ordinance; and provided further that, appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of a two-thirds' vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the City, and for purposes other than those covered by the specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to permit timely submission of said appropriations to the Lake County Auditor; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
