

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-40

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AMEND THE CONTRACT WITH NRG BUSINESS MARKETING LLC TO FURNISH NATURAL GAS AND RELATED SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY'S PUBLIC BUILDINGS BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SERVICE LOCATION UNDER THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE CURRENT AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Willoughby is currently under contract with NRG Business Marketing LLC for the purchase of natural gas and related services for the City of Willoughby's public buildings through November 30, 2029; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to add a new service location to the Agreement at the current price and conditions of the Agreement effective June 1, 2026 through November 30, 2029; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the City to provide an additional service location to the Agreement with NRG Business Marketing LLC for the furnishing of natural gas and related services at 37733 Euclid Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to amend the contract with NRG Business Marketing LLC, 804 Carnegie Center, Princeton, NJ 08540, to furnish natural gas and related services for the City of Willoughby's public buildings by the addition of a new service location to the Agreement and under the current terms and conditions of the Agreement.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to add a new service location under the same low price as the current contract; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
