

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2026-60**

**A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2026-46 SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE QUESTION OF A RENEWAL OF A TWO (2) MILL TAX LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RESURFACING, AND REPAIR OF STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES IN THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Board of Elections has informed the City that due to a change in O.R.C. Section 5705.03 since the 2021 passage of this Resolution, the State of Ohio now requires additional information in the Resolution stating the levy's effective rate, expressed in dollars, rounded to the nearest dollar, for each one hundred thousand dollars of the county auditor's market value; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2026-46 is hereby repealed and a corrected copy will be prepared;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That Resolution No. 2026-46 submitting to the electors of the City of Willoughby, the question of a renewal of a two (2) mill tax levy for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges in the City is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to allow for immediate preparation of a new Resolution; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

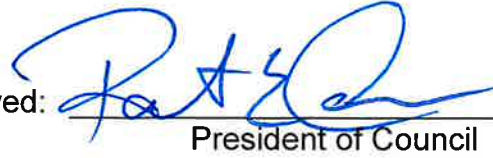
