

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-76

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000 FROM THE WILLOUGHBY SEWER FUND FOR THE EMERGENCY REPLACEMENT OF A SANITARY SEWER MAIN STRUCTURE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, approximately 200 feet north of 37990 Tamarac Blvd., a sanitary sewer main structure failed and caused a sudden leakage of sanitary sewage into the environment; and

WHEREAS, this sanitary sewer main conveys sanitary sewage to the Lakeshore Boulevard lift station and its failure presents a clear and present danger to the environment and to the health and safety of residents in the area; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this emergency, the Service Director and City Engineer had to take immediate action to contract for the repairs without competitive bidding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 from the Willoughby Sewer Fund for the emergency replacement of a manhole structure for the sanitary sewer main is approved and the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to proceed with such replacement.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to provide uninterrupted services to the users of the sanitary sewer; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
