

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-85

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$98,811.40 FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2027 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTORS FROM STATEWIDE FORD FOR USE BY THE WILLOUGHBY POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police received a quote of \$98,811.40 from Statewide Ford through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program for the purchase of two (2) 2027 Ford Police Interceptors for use by the Willoughby Police Department; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to purchase the two (2) 2027 Ford Police Interceptors from Statewide Ford without bidding or advertising;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an expenditure of \$98,811.40 for the purchase of two (2) 2027 Ford Police Interceptors for use by the Willoughby Police Department is hereby approved and the Chief of Police is authorized to proceed with such purchase from Statewide Ford, 1108 West Main Street, Van Wert, OH 45891; said amount to be expended from the Safety Tax Levy Fund.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to order vehicles immediately; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
