

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-94

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TRAX CONSTRUCTION CO. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$489,684 FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LINCOLN AVENUE STORM SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of June, 2026, bids were received by the City Engineer for the Lincoln Avenue Storm Sewer Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the bid received from Trax Construction Co. in the amount of \$489,684 was, in the opinion of the Council of the City, the lowest and best bid received thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Trax Construction Co., 30701 Euclid Avenue, Wickliffe, OH 44092 in the amount of \$489,684 for implementation of the Lincoln Avenue Storm Sewer Replacement Project, in accordance with the specifications and bid submitted; said amount to be expended from the Storm Water Capital Fund.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is further authorized to execute any and all additional documents and forms necessary to the implementation of said contract.

SECTION 3. The bid deposit for the lowest and best bidder shall be returned upon execution of the contract.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason to provide for immediate bidding and construction; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
