

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-101

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A FOUR (4) YEAR AGREEMENT WITH MEDICOUNT MANAGEMENT, INC. WITH SUCCESSIVE ONE (1) YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS AT A 0.25% INCREASE OVER THE BASE RATE PER YEAR FOR SERVICES NECESSARY TO THE COLLECTION OF RATES CHARGED BY THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY FOR ALL FIRE DEPARTMENT EMERGENCY MEDICAL AND RESCUE SQUAD SERVICES PROVIDED TO THE RESIDENTS AND NON-RESIDENTS OF THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY, THE COUNTY OF LAKE, AND THE STATE OF OHIO:

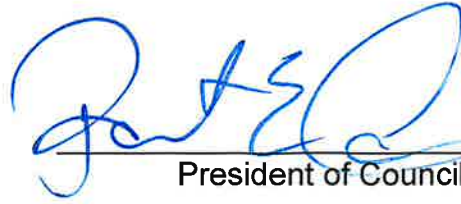
SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a four (4) year Agreement with Medicount Management, Inc., 10361 Spartan Drive, Cincinnati, Ohio 45215 with automatic, successive one (1) year renewal options at a 0.25% increase over the base rate per year, necessary to the collection of rates charged by the City of Willoughby for all Fire Department EMS services provided to residents and non-residents of the City in an amount to be determined monthly in accordance with the Agreement; said Agreement substantially in the form now on file in the Law Department; such expenditure to be made from the General Fund.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such actions were conducted in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Willoughby.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the community; and for the further reason that the new Agreement effective immediately has new terms; and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall be in full force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
